Three proposed construction projects near Colonial Blvd. & Metro Pkwy. and on the approach path to runway 23 at Page Field, may affect the useable length of 23.

Port Authority opposes the displacement of the threshold of runway 23.

An evaluation of the Bravo hangars, as well as other hangars damaged by hurricane Wilma is being done. The report will be presented to Port Authority in January 2006 for their consideration.

The ALP for Page Field is at FAA, waiting for approval. When approval is made it will be posted at the Aviation Center.

The fire inspector for the Port Authority has resigned. A new inspector will be hired soon.

Tenants wishing to substitute another aircraft in their hangar must complete the proper paperwork with Page Field Aviation Center, and remember there is a 6 month maximum per year for substitutions.

Plans for a picnic shelter at Foxtrot hangars are complete and in the process of permitting.

The new T-hangars should be finished by June 2006.

Self serve fuel has been relocated and should be back in operation by January 1, 2006.

The self serve maintenance is nearly finished and should be in service by the middle of January 2006.

Bob Schultz - Page Tower
The major repairs to the tower are finished. One window in the tower cab was damaged in hurricane Wilma, and will be repaired. Operation are averaging about 6% above a year ago. Ground traffic around the construction is going well.
