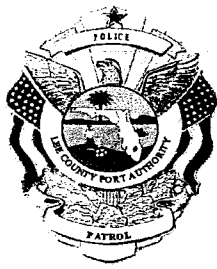

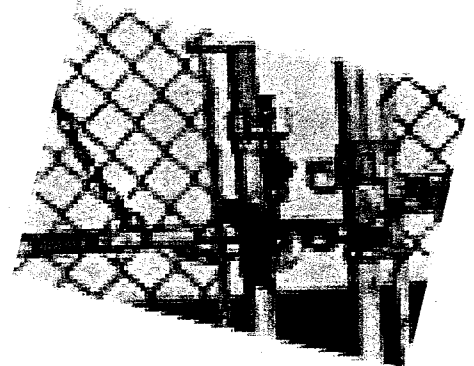

Dear Page Field Tenant:

It is time once again to change the gate entry codes at Page Field. Effective December 13, 2010 the new code will be [REDACTED]

Please help us keep Page safe and secure by not sharing the gate code with others. If you are having friends meet you at Page, please meet them at the gate and escort them to your hangar or tie-down. It is too easy for a person unfamiliar with airports to become disoriented and wind up in a place they don't belong.

It is also very important that everyone wait for the gate to close behind them as they enter and exit airport property. One of the leading causes of runway incursions is what the FAA refers to as a vehicle pedestrian deviation (VPD) which is typically the result of an unauthorized vehicle entering the AOA.
