

Bylaws

of

Page Field Association

(Approved January 14, 2004)

Article I. Name and location

The name of the organization shall be the Page Field Association. The principal office of the organization for transaction of business is located at 501 Danley Drive, Fort Myers, Florida 33907

Article II. Objectives of the Page Field Association

The purpose of the Association is to serve as a forum for users and supporters of the airport to communicate with each other; and to resolve problems and undertake initiatives that benefit Page Field, airport users, and the community.

The Association's ongoing responsibilities are to enhance and promote:

- Safe ground and flight operations
- Communication among all users of the airport
- Economic development of the airport
- The value of Page Field to the community
- Airport facilities development
- User relationships with governmental and public officials and organizations with influence over Page Field.

Article III. Members

The following are all members of the Page Field Association:

- All student and certified pilots and aircraft owners operating at Page Field
- Owners and employees of commercial businesses based at Page Field
- Commercial aircraft operators based at Page Field
- Flight school personnel based at Page Field
- Members of pilots and aircraft clubs and organizations based at Page Field
- Page Field and Lee County Port Authority staff
- Page Field air traffic control tower personnel

Each member shall have one vote.

Article IV. Meetings

The **Page Field Association** shall conduct a general meeting once a month in a location designated by the **President** unless cancelled in advance by the **President**. Notice of meetings will be disseminated as widely as possible including by email. Special meetings may be called by the **President** at any time. Notice to the membership of special meetings must be made at least one week in advance of the meeting. On issues requiring a vote at any general or special meeting (except revision of the Bylaws) a simple majority of the members present and voting is required for passage.

Article V. Officers

The officers of the Association shall be:

President
Vice President
Secretary
Treasurer
Immediate Past President

The **President** presides at all meetings, signs official correspondence, coordinates the activities of the Association, appoints committee chairs unless otherwise specified, and carries out the collective wishes of the membership. The President also (in consultation with the other officers) appoints the **Nominating Committee**,

The **Vice President** performs the duties of the **President** in the **President's** absence, and any other duties specified by the **President**.

The **Secretary** handles correspondence, assists the **President** in communications, and maintains Association records with the exception of financial records.

The **Treasurer** handles all business affairs of the Association and maintains financial records.

The **Immediate Past President** serves to assist the **President** by providing continuity in the operation of the Association.

All officers shall serve for one calendar year and may be reelected. Any vacancies occurring during the year (other than Immediate Past President) will be filled by a member selected by the **President** in consultation with the remaining officers.

Article VI. Nominating Committee

The **President** shall appoint a three-member **Nominating Committee** prior to October 15 of each year, or as soon thereafter as possible. No more than one current Association Officer may serve on the **Nominating Committee**. The duty of the Nominating Committee is to provide a slate of candidates for **President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer**. This slate will be presented at the November meeting of the Association, or as soon thereafter as possible. Candidates for office should be as representative of the Page Field Association Members (as listed in Article III) as possible.

Article VII. Election of Officers

The election of officers shall take place at the December general meeting of the Association, or as soon thereafter as possible. In addition to the slate presented by the **Nominating Committee**, nominations for any position may be made from the floor by those members present. Nominations will be closed by a proper motion made, seconded, and passed. If there is more than one candidate for any office, paper ballots will be used. A simple majority of those attending the meeting and voting is required for election to each office. The newly elected officers take office on January 1, or as soon thereafter as possible.

Article VIII. Amendment of Bylaws

These Bylaws may be amended at a general or special meeting of the Association by a vote of two-thirds of those present. Proposed amendments must be submitted to the President at least one month in advance of the meeting in which they are to be acted upon. The **President** is obligated to present the amendments.
